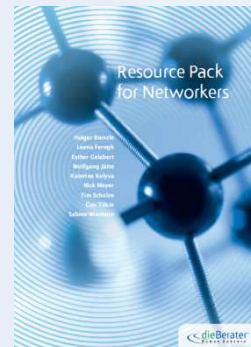
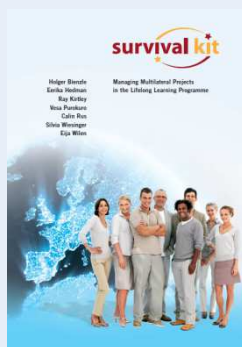

3. Define exploitation actions & strategies to address key market players
 - i.e. workshops, mailings, events held by stakeholders
 - creating incentives to involve stakeholders throughout the project
4. Copyright agreement
